

# 2017 EPA WPS Update and Train-The-Trainer Workshop

All farmworkers must be trained under the EPA Worker Protection Standard (WPS) if a farm uses any pesticides, including, those approved for organic production and other general use pesticides. The agricultural worker employer is responsible for complying with all components of WPS including the training of farmworkers. This training can only be provided by an individual who has a pesticide certification license or has attended an approved EPA WPS Train-the-Trainer workshop.
