RULES & GUIDELINES

Leadline: ages 5-7 as of 1/1/16 Small equine measures less than or equal to 48" at the withers
Walk-Trot: ages 8-18 as of 1/1/16
Junior: ages 8-13 as of 1/1/16
Senior: ages 14-18 as of 1/1/16
Adult & Adult Walk Trot: 19 and older as of 1/1/16

- 1 Mass. State law requires proof of negative Coggins test from each horse owner.
- 2 Classes will be conducted according to the Massachusetts 4-H Horse Show Rules.
- 3 No alcoholic beverages allowed on grounds.
- 4 No refunds granted unless bona fide injury to horse or rider.
(Final decision determined by Horse Show Committee).
- 5 No stallions allowed on the grounds.
- 6 Animals who tend to kick must wear a red ribbon on tail.
- 7 Riders adding classes must do so 2 classes in advance to allow time to process entries. There will be two stable calls prior to each class; class will be closed two minutes after final call.
- 8 Horse Show Committee reserves the right to combine, divide, cancel, or vary classes if the situation warrants
- 9 Decisions of the judge are final; class routine may be changed at the discretion of the judge.
- 10 Courtesy is to be shown to the judge always; lack of such will result in dismissal from the show with no refunds
- 11 Hard soled shoes or boots must be worn in all classes.
- 12 ASTM approved helmets must be worn by all participants 19 and under as of January 1, 2016.
- 13 We love dogs, but please keep them in the spectator area on the hill or at your trailer and away from the horses in the ring waiting area.
- 14 Horses must be in complete control before leaving the ring. Horses must be kept at a walk outside the show ring, except in the designated practice areas
- 15 Poor sportsmanship or mistreatment of the animal on the part of the exhibitor or unwarranted misbehavior on the part of a horse will subject exhibitor to dismissal from the ring or show grounds
- 16 Patterns will be posted for Open Showmanship, trail and jumping classes
- 17 In order to enter 4-H performance classes, riders are required to enter 4-H fitting and showmanship class.
- 18 WT riders may not enter 4-H performance classes
- 19 Gymkhana division riders must be in the same division as for performance classes
- 20 Please remember that adults or trainers may not groom, prepare or assist with a 4-H exhibitor's project horse if it is in 4-H classes. Exceptions include loading/unloading; horse holding and leading; harnessing and tightening girths; giving a leg up; and other assistance if common sense dictates safety is a concern.
