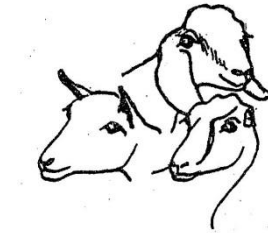


“SHOW LIKE A PRO”

You will bring your own goat with you to work on along with your clippers and supplies. We will have a fitting supplier trailer available on the fairgrounds. Pens are available but you must bring your own stand.



You are required to have a Veterinarian issued Health Certificate on your goat(s).

Directions to Three County Fairgrounds:

91 South – take exit 20, take a left at the set of lights (Damon Road), stay straight until second set of lights and take a right onto Rt. 9 west. Continue straight through the second set of lights and watch for signs on the left indicating the fairgrounds and the UMass Dairy Academy.

91 North – take exit 19 (Amherst/Northampton), take a left at the bottom of ramp through lights onto Rt. 9 west, Go straight through second set of lights and watch for signs on the left indicating the fairgrounds and the UMass Dairy Academy.
