Thank you for registering for the 2018 4-H Summer of Science Program! We are once again pleased to be offering this program on the University of Massachusetts, Amherst campus. Dates are **Sunday, June 24th – Tuesday, June 26th, 2018**. We will have a combination of a daytime track on developing Apps, an assortment of Veterinary Science workshops, and large group activities during the three days of the program.

Registration, check-in and pick up: Registration and check-in begins at **2:00 p.m.** on Sunday, June 24th with program activities beginning at 3:00 pm. Registration will be held in the lobby of **Johnson Dormitory** (please see map of the UMass Amherst campus for directions to the dorm). Pick up is at this same location at **4:30 p.m.** on Tuesday, June 26th. **All youth must be picked up at this time, no exceptions.** Parents interested in joining us at 2pm for the showcase of their Apps in the conference center are welcome.

What to Bring:

- ✓ Sleeping bag or sheets/blanket and pillow (this will not be provided)
- ✓ Toiletries/towel
- ✓ 2 changes of clothes/sleepwear
- ✓ Sweatshirt or jacket
- ✓ Umbrella or raincoat
- ✓ Water bottle
- ✓ **Fan - *The weather is unpredictable and the dorms can get hot, so please send your child with a fan.***
- ✓ The campus store will be open and only a small amount of money is advised to bring

Medications: If your child needs to take medication, they must be able to self-medicate and keep track of their own schedule. If the medication needs to be refrigerated, one is available.
