

Please mail in this application form with a \$30 nonrefundable reservation fee to secure your child's attendance at the UMass Beef academy. **Deadline for academy application is May 1, 2018** If a parent would like to attend the overnight academy, a \$25 payment must be submitted along with your child's application to ensure available space.

The reservation fee will be deducted from the total tuition amount of \$50, with the balance due at check-in. **Contact your 4-H educator for available scholarships.**

All participants will be required to submit the following forms prior to the event, which will be emailed to you upon receipt of registration:

- Proof of the child's physical examination within the last two years
- Parental consent and information regarding medical treatment for the child
- Parental assumption of financial and legal responsibility for any medical charges or damages arising out of the child's or your participation in the activities
- Proof of health for any animal brought to the academy

Upon receipt of your child's reservation, you will be emailed:

- Permission and Liability Release form
- Member Code of Conduct form

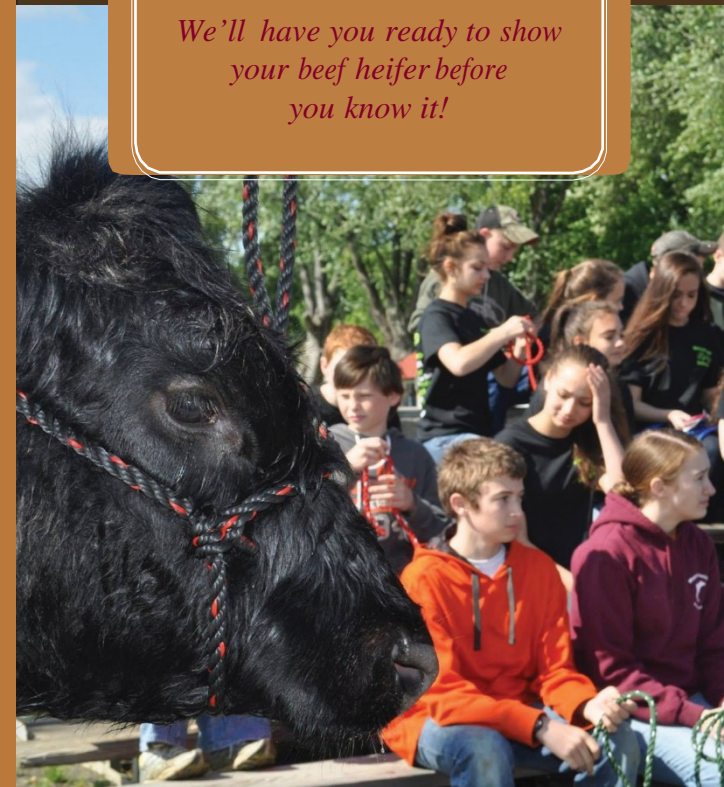

The weekend will focus on fitting and showing beef cattle-related workshops for young people ages 8 to 18. Youth with two or more years' experience are able to attend a two-day academy for \$50, while youth with less than two years' experience can attend as day participants for \$25. Parents may attend the overnight Advanced academy for \$50, the Novice day event for \$25, or a Parent day academy for \$10.

Youth staying the weekend will be housed in UMass dormitories (just bring your toiletries).

Screened volunteers will act as chaperones. Meals will be served.

Youth bringing their heifers are expected to bring grain, hay, feed tubs, and all fitting equipment for their animal. We will supply their bedding. An overnight crew will be based at the barns..
