Information & Guidelines

What is the Betty Oligny 4-H Scholarship?

It is a privately endowed fund established by the Hampshire County 4-H Advisory Council in 1993 in memory of Betty Oligny. For 42 years, Betty was a Hampshire County 4-H volunteer serving young people and adults throughout Hampshire County.

Betty was active in the Interstate 4-H Exchange Program, often chaperoning trips across the country. She was a mainstay at the Exchange Cummington. She dedicated her life to serving youth through 4-H.

What is the Rebecca J. Dea 4-H Scholarship?

It is a 4-H scholarship in remembrance of former 4-H Agent and Camp Howe Director, "Ms. Dea".

Who is eligible?

Any student having graduated from high school, or who will graduate in May or June and who plans to attend a school or college full time, may apply. The youth must be currently enrolled in the Hampshire County 4-H Program for a minimum of two (2) years.

How much is available?

Up to \$1,000.00 is available each year and may be given in one or more awards, or withheld and allowed to accumulate.
