



The Bristol County 4-H Association is pleased to announce that it is offering a \$500 scholarship in memory of Connie Agrella. The scholarship will be available to any active Bristol County 4-H Member in his/her senior year of high school or currently enrolled in an institution of higher education and have not reached his/her 21<sup>st</sup> birthday as of January 1, 2019. We hope to confer this scholarship at the awards ceremony of the recipient's high school graduation or other appropriate occasion in 2020. The requirements for applying are as follows:

- Applicant must be a three (3) or more year **active** member of the Bristol County 4-H Program.
- Applicant has been accepted in a college program or to a school of higher learning or currently attending a school of higher learning.
- Applicant must show 4-H participation, leadership, citizenship, and awards/ recognition. In addition, applicant must show involvement in education (such as high school, college/higher education institution, home schooling, GED) extra curricular activities and outside interests, such as church, clubs, sports, music, etc.
- Applicant must submit a brief essay in 12 Font (maximum one (1) typewritten page, double-spaced) on plans for the future: "How 4-H Has Prepared Me for My Future Endeavors".
- Applicant must submit a high school transcript, or equivalent, if home-schooled or GED student. A student of higher education must submit the same equivalent.
- Applicant must submit a copy of an acceptance letter to an institution of higher learning or proof of continuation in an institution of higher education.
- Applicant must submit a copy of the first semester's 2019 grades and proof of continuing education to receive the scholarship monies in January 2020.
