

### **County 4-H Horse Councils & State Horse Advisory**



The county 4-H horse councils are made up of representatives of each of the 4-H horse clubs, and supports 4-H horse activities at the club, county, and state level in Massachusetts.

The State 4-H Horse Advisory Committee is made-up of representatives from each of the county or regional horse councils. They set-up contests for the 4-H horse program. Help to fundraise for national contests and serves as a governing body for horse programming in the state.




