

## Massachusetts State 4-H Senior Quilt Evaluation

All 4-H seniors are invited to participate in this state competitive quilt evaluation. The first part requires registration for the New England Center by July 15<sup>th</sup> followed by a separate deadline to enter the quilt for construction judging. On 4-H Day at the Eastern States Exposition the participant takes part in the New England Center orientation at 8 a.m., model practice, 2 fashion shows (11 am & 2 pm), and marching in the 5 p.m. Big E parade. Ribbons & awards are given following the second fashion show.

### Who may enter:

- ➔ Currently enrolled Massachusetts 4-H senior members (14-18 years of age as of 1/1/16) in good standing

### What may be entered:

- ➔ One quilt (top, filling, backing) that has been finished by the “tie” method or either hand or machine quilted
- ➔ All work must be done by the exhibitor (no commercially finished quilts allowed)
- ➔ Quilts must have been completed after October 1, 2015
- ➔ Minimum size: 3600 square inches, such as 60” x 60” and 50” and 72”
- ➔ Original designs, commercial patterns, etc. are all eligible
- ➔ Level of difficulty should be appropriate for senior level competition

**September 17** – Modeling and parade at the Eastern States Exposition (4-H Day) in West Springfield. Orientation at 8 a.m.

Registered participants will receive fair information and tickets in early September. All participants and their driver will receive free entry into the fair, free meals in the 4-H dormitory, and a free parking pass. For those who would like to stay overnight on Friday, 9/16, a 4-H dormitory is on the premises.

⇒ Include pattern directions (either from commercial pattern with any variations you have made or self-written instructions for original designs)

⇒ On a separate piece of paper attach **one (1)** of the following:

- Photocopy of picture from quilt instructions or book
- Draw a detailed sketch of your quilt

⇒ On a separate piece of paper attach a sample of all fabrics, batting, etc used. Label each piece as to where it was used in your quilt *and* its fiber content. (For prints, cut a large piece and fold before attaching.)
