



## Corn Hybrid Trial Entry Form 2018

University of Massachusetts Amherst

You are invited to submit new (or old) corn hybrids for evaluation in 2018 at the University of Massachusetts agronomy farm. We will be assessing silage and grain yield of hybrids grown in the Connecticut River Valley, to be shared with New England farmers. All trials will be conducted at the University of Massachusetts Agronomy Farm in South Deerfield, MA. Yields for silage will be available in October 2018. Grain yields will be available later; in November or December. We will use “conventional” herbicides in these trials and welcome hybrids without genetically modified traits, as well as those with specialty traits. Trial fee is \$100 per hybrid.
