

# Hacer compost es fácil!

Para hacer compost, solo siga estos simples pasos:

... y una parte de "materiales verdes"

## 1. Agregue tres partes de "materiales marrones"...

Las hojas secas, la paja, el heno de las marismas, el papel triturado y el cartón (periódicos, servilletas de papel, platos de papel, bolsas de papel), las astillas, el aserrín, las pinochas (las pinochas no deberían constituir más del 10 % del material total de la pila).

## ...and one part "greens"

Grass clippings, weeds (not laden with seeds), vegetable and fruit wastes, seaweed, eggshells, coffee grounds and filters, tea bags, manure (horse, cow, rabbit, chicken, goat, gerbil, etc).

## 2. Mix or layer materials.

After every 12" or so, add a few shovelfuls of rich soil or compost.

## 3. Keep it damp and aerated.

Wait a few months, and voila...black gold!

For best results, and to keep out odors and pests,

### DO NOT ADD:

- ♦ Meat, bones, fat, grease, oils
- ♦ Peanut butter
- ♦ Dairy products
- ♦ Cooked foods with sauces or butter
- ♦ Dog and cat manure
- ♦ Diseased plants
- ♦ Weeds gone to seed
- ♦ Weeds that spread by roots and runners (vines)
