Tolerances provided here are determined at Rosebrook bog in Wareham and confirmed at State Bog in East Wareham.

For comparison purposes, this year we are including photos from additional locations.

 On May 6<sup>th</sup>, at Rosebrook and at State Bog, some early elongation was seen on Early Black, Howes, and Ben Lear; while Stevens remained at cabbage head stage at both locations.

Newer hybrids at State Bog were generally similar to Ben Lear (early or full elongation stage).

Note: starting with cabbage head stage, development continues even when visual stages appear not to change. Each stage, starting with cabbage head, only lasts 5-7 days!

Elongation stage bud tolerance for Early Black and Howes is 27°F; for Ben Lear and Stevens it is 29.5°F.

Cabbage head stage tolerance for Stevens is 27°F.

 The Dee model predicts bud swell at 150 GDD (degree days). On April 28<sup>th</sup>, East Wareham reached that benchmark. Bud swell was observed in the field on April 26-27<sup>th</sup>.

The Dee model predicts cabbage head at 200 GDD; East Wareham reached that benchmark on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. We first observed this stage on April 30<sup>th</sup>.
