

January Meeting Registration Form

PESTICIDE CERTIFICIATION, CREDITS AND MEETINGS!

Have you remembered to renew your pesticide certification? It must be done by **December 31, 2022**! It is needed for Diazinon, Bravo (any chlorothalonil), Intrepid or Invertid, Actara, Zeus and Fanfare, so make sure you have it. If you need help, **I CAN HELP YOU**! Give me a call- **Marty 508-265-6921**.

Every grower is now audited by MDAR (Massachusetts Department of Agricultural Resources) every 3 years. Again, make sure you have 12 credits stacked up for your next recertification. Audit period in 2022 ran from July 2019 through December 2022.


