Things to Know:

- Entries can be done in batches so if you have some things ready, go ahead and enter.
- You can even come back again to enter more projects before judging begins.
- Entering projects in batches should make it easier for members who have a lot of entries.

Process to Enter:

- You can enter one or more class entries you have ready and submit an invoice.
- The office will check-in those entries.
- Once the items on that invoice are checked in you can then go enter others.
- ** **Note:** If you have not completed your re-enrollment or are just in the process of joining 4-H, don't worry! We will "sync" again with 4honline after the New Year and then you can submit your entries. Keep working on them over the winter holiday break!

Some important dates:

- March 2nd: Fair closes entries for judging
- March 14th: 7 PM Zoom awards ceremony

Animal Science Programs & Updates



HEY! If the weather is not making you think of Spring, then you should check out the list of 4-H Animal Science events listed below. There are TONS of opportunities to get out and get going with your livestock project. All of these events address the first three objectives of our program: to develop and foster life skills through positive interactions with others, to teach scientific principles of Animal Science to young people, to increase the awareness of animal industry issues among youth. Make sure your enrollment is up-to-date!

Animal Verification Forms

Now is the time to print off your Animal Verification Forms to plan for the upcoming show season. Lease Forms are also due at the same time. Animal Verification Forms are to be completed for all livestock, dogs, and horses that you plan to show at a 4-H fair, dog academies, and/or Big E 4-H Shows. Note: Lambs and kids born after June 1st are still eligible to show based on your fair's requirements, but you will still need to file a Verification Form on them once they are born. Verification Forms are due to your county/regional 4-H office by the following dates:

- New Date: May 1st Horse
 (only if planning to show at the Sept. New England 4-H Horse Show at the Big E)
- May 1st Dairy Cattle, Beef Cattle, and Working Steers
- June 1st Goat, Sheep, Llama, Alpaca, Swine, and Dog
