Things to Know:

- **Solution** Entries can be done in batches so if you have some things ready, go ahead and enter.
- * You can even come back again to enter more projects before judging begins.
- Entering projects in batches should make it easier for members who have a lot of entries.

Process to Enter:

- You can enter one or more class entries you have ready and submit an invoice.
- **The office will check-in those entries.**
- Once the items on that invoice are checked in you can then go enter others.
- ** **Note:** If you have not completed your re-enrollment or are just in the process of joining 4-H, don't worry! We will "sync" again with 4honline after the New Year and then you can submit your entries. Keep working on them over the winter holiday break!

Please take a moment to poke around, especially if you haven't seen the site in a while.

ALSO, there's A LOT going on in Massachusetts 4-H ALL.THE.TIME. So here are a few friendly reminders for you to stay on top of your 4-H game:

Animal Verification Forms

Now is the time to print off your Animal Verification Forms to plan for the upcoming show season. Lease Forms are also due at the same time. Animal Verification Forms are to be completed for all livestock, dogs, and horses that you plan to show at a 4-H fair, dog academies, and/or Big E 4-H Shows. Note: Lambs and kids born after June 1st are still eligible to show based on your fair's requirements, but you will still need to file a Verification Form on them once they are born. Verification Forms are due to your county/regional 4-H office by the following dates:

- New Date: May 1st Horse (only if planning to show at the Sept. New England 4-H Horse Show at the Big E)
- May 1st Dairy Cattle, Beef Cattle, and Working Steers
- June 1st Goat, Sheep, Llama, Alpaca and Swine, Dog

- Livestock Lease Form
- Beef Lease Form (Youth cannot show a leased steer at the Big E)
- Horse Verification Form
- Dog Verification Form

New England Beef Program

Youth ages 12-18 years of age (as of January 1st) are eligible to try-out for the New England 4-H Beef Show that is held in September. A NEW Massachusetts' Application for the Big E has been developed and can be found at

Youth must own their beef steer and the beef heifers can be either owned or leased. A youth may enter up to three animals at this show. For more information on this show, please go to
