# **UMass Extension Career Exploration Series**

Have you ever heard of Avian Flu or Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE)? Imagine being a veterinarian, able to help take care of animals not just locally but nationally!



Nicole Giguere & Kim Haling get to do just that. They investigate potential foreign animal disease outbreaks and work to get rid of diseases that are already in the U.S. They take lab samples, trace animal movements, and inspect labs and production facilities. When animal disease outbreaks occur outside of the U.S., they work to help contain the disease and minimize impact and animal suffering. They also teach about threats to animals and how to prevent spread.

They are part of many programs including Marketing and Regulatory Programs (MRP), Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS), and Foreign Animal Disease Diagnosticians (FADD).

### Save the date for UMass 4-H Dog Academy!

UMass 4-H Dog Academy will be held at 4-H Camp Farley May 12 - 14<sup>th</sup>. Dog Academy is open to enrolled 4-H members (ages 8 - 18 as of 1/1/2023). All handling pairs (4-H member and dog) must be previously evaluated in order to attend dog academy. Members may choose to stay the weekend or attend for the day on Saturday 5/13/23. 4-H members who are not bringing a dog are able to come for the Saturday program on 5/13/21. Cloverbud members (ages 5 - 7 as of 1/1/2023) may attend for the day on Saturday or for the weekend with a parent who stays in the cabin with them. Cloverbuds must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

#### **Animal Verification Forms**

Now is the time to print off your Animal Verification Forms to plan for the upcoming show season. Lease Forms are also due at the same time. Animal Verification Forms are to be completed for all livestock, dogs, and horses that you plan to show at a 4-H fair, dog academies, and/or Big E 4-H Shows. *Note:* Lambs and kids born after June 1<sup>st</sup> are still eligible to show based on your fair's requirements, but you will still need to file a Verification Form on them once they are born.

Verification Forms are due to your county/regional 4-H office by the following dates:

- April 10<sup>th</sup> Horse (only if planning to show at the Sept. New England 4-H Horse Show at the Big E)
- May 1<sup>st</sup> Dairy Cattle, Beef Cattle, and Working Steers
- June 1<sup>st</sup> Goat, Sheep, Llama, Alpaca and Swine, Dog

### **Horse Chat**



# **4-H Health Safety Policy**

UMass 4-H Policy on testing positive for Covid and isolating as consistent with UMass Amherst Policy: <u>https://www.umass.edu/coronavirus/isolation-and-quarantine-guide</u>

#### **Calculating Isolation:**

Day 0 is your first day of symptoms or a positive viral test. Day 1 is the first full day after your symptoms developed or your test specimen was collected. If you have COVID-19 or have symptoms, isolate for at least five days. On Day 6, leave isolation (if you are able to wear a mask at all times when around other people, including in your household, through day 10). You may remove your mask prior to day 10, if you have had two negative tests taken 48 hours apart

Youth and volunteers may return to 4-H activities with a mask on Day 6 if they are asymptomatic. Please do not attend events if you are sick. Admittance to 4-H events is up to the discretion of the organizer. Attendees who are symptomatic may be denied entry or asked to leave.
