# Parents/Drivers

You must be a fully screened 4-H volunteer if:

- You are in charge of a 4-H group that includes children other than your own
- You will be driving 4-H children other than your own whose parents are not in the same car
- You will be on the fairgrounds overseeing 4-H children other than your own

If you are not currently a fully screened 4-H volunteer (or are not sure if you are) you must contact your local 4-H office immediately to begin this process. You must be fully screened by the beginning of August or we will not be able to allow you to chaperone children other than your own.

You do not need to be a fully screened volunteer if:

- You are only transporting and in charge of your own child(ren) the day of participation and you will not be staying in the dorm.

## IMPORTANT:

- The Moses Dorm and the cafeteria will not be available during the 2021 Big E. This was a health department and Big E decision.
- Those participating in the 4-H New England Center activity are allowed to bring in food. For food safety reasons, be sure to bring your food in a cooler.
- Parents or their designee are responsible to chaperone their child or those in their care both at the New England Center and if visiting the Big E fair. Youth members are not allowed to visit the fair without an adult.
- All those selected to participate in the New England Center 4-H Activities will receive an entry ticket for the participating 4-H member, an entry ticket for one parent or designated chaperone, and a parking pass for the day of participation. All others will need to purchase entry tickets for the Big E.
- A participating family has the option of staying at a local hotel. This is considered to be a personal expense and not covered by the UMass Extension 4-H Program.
