Lead Line	Ages 7 and under as of 1/1/2022	Has not shown walk/trot.
4-H & Open Walk/Trot	Ages 8-18 as of 1/1/2022	Has not shown at the canter.
4-H & Open Junior	Ages 8-13 as of 1/1/2022	
4-H & Open Senior	Ages 14-18 as of 1/1/2022	
4-H Alumni	Ages 19 and over that are a PAST 4-H member as of 1/1/2022	This is a walk/trot canter class.
Adult	Ages 19 and over as of 1/1/2022	
4-H & Open Small Equine	4-H: Ages 8-18 as of 1/1/2022 Open: Any age	This division is open to ponies, miniature horses, mules and donkeys (48" and under).
Ranch Horse 18 & Under	Riders Age 18 and under	This is <u>not</u> a 4-H division, but is open to 4-H Riders
Ranch Horse Adult	Riders Age 19 and over	This is <u>not</u> a 4-H division, but is open to 4-H Riders

ALL 4-H PARTICIPANTS MUST BE CURRENTLY ENROLLED 4-H MEMBERS.

- 1) Walk- trot classes are for the rider who has not shown at the canter/lope at any show. No Green Horses!
- 2) Walk/Trot riders may not enter a class requiring a canter/lope.
- 3) Anyone who acts as a leader in the Lead Line division must be at least 16 years of age.
- 4) You may only ride 1 horse per division.
- 5) Open riders may not ride in 4-H divisions. You are an Open rider if you are not a currently enrolled 4H member.
- 6) The show committee reserves the right to combine, cancel or split classes.
- 7) Return of entry fee only for injury to horse or rider or class cancellation (with Vet or M.D. note).
- 8) Classes will not be held except in the event of tack changes, for which the announcer must be alerted 2 classes before the affected class is scheduled. 3 minute tack hold.
- 9) No changing of age division after having ridden in any class.
- 10) **ALL RIDERS 18 AND UNDER MUST WEAR ASTM/SEI approved helmets with chinstraps fastened whenever mounted on show grounds. Recommended for ages 19 and over.**
- 11) State law requires an annual negative Coggins test and recommends rabies.
- 12) The Judges' decisions are final when governing any question or dispute. No one may approach a Judge without receiving permission from the Ring Steward.
- 13) Tie downs, martingales, dropped nosebands, and easy stops are prohibited. Proper tack and riding attire required for all classes.
- 14) **No Dogs allowed on show premises.**
- 15) Horses must be serviceably sound.
- 16) Abusive treatment of horses will result in disqualification and /or dismissal from show grounds.
- 17) New England 4-H Rule Book & USEF rules shall apply.
- 18) Red ribbons shall be tied on the horsetail of known kickers and mares in heat.
- 19) Horses should be confined to warm up areas and are prohibited from ANNOUNCER AND SECRETARY BOOTH AREAS.
- 20) NO Stallions.
- 21) NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED ON SHOW GROUNDS.
- 22) Ranch Horse division – No silver on halter. Minimal silver on tack. Rider attire: Jeans, Button-up long sleeve shirt, Boots with a heel, Helmet for 18 & under, Hat or helmet for adult.
