The Massachusetts 4-H Key Award recognizes 4-H Members ages 15-18 for their outstanding personal development and overall achievement gained through 4-H participation. The 4-H Program strives to inspire members to become active youth leaders who communicate effectively and give back to their local communities. To be eligible for the Key Award, 4-H members must be at least 15 years old, have completed at least 3 years in $4-\mathrm{H}$, and achieve a minimum of 100 points on an application judged by their local UMass 4-H Extension Educator. This prestigious award may only be earned once by any individual $4-\mathrm{H}$ member.

To be eligible for consideration, 4-H Members must:

1. Have reached 15 years of age by January $1^{\text {St }}$ of the current 4-H year.
2. Have been a $4-\mathrm{H}$ member for at least 3 years.
3. Have submitted 4-H Project Records. At a minimum submitted records during the same year as the application.
4. Submit a brief essay describing the impact 4-H membership has had on their personal development.
5. Return completed application to regional 4-H office by November 1 with all required signatures

## SCORING

1. Applicant must receive a minimum of 25 points in any given section, and at least 100 total points on the total Key Award Application.
