

## GLOSSARY/TERMS FOR RABBIT AND CAVY

<b>ARBA</b>	American Rabbit Breeders Association
<b>Boar</b>	A male cavy
<b>Cavy</b>	Correct term for Guinea Pig
<b>Cavy – Intermediate</b>	A cavy up to 6 months old and weighing between 22 ounces through 32 ounces
<b>Cavy – Junior</b>	A cavy up to 4 months old and between 12 and 22 ounces
<b>Cavy – Senior</b>	A cavy 6 months of age or over 32 ounces
<b>Class</b>	A category for show based upon the age and sex
<b>Cloverbud</b>	Exhibitors ag 5 to 7
<b>Guinea Pig</b>	The common name for <i>Cavia porcellus</i> or cavy
<b>Intermediate Buck or Doe</b>	Term used in breeds have 6 showroom classes. A rabbit 6 months of age and under 8 months of age, or meeting weight requirements of the breed standard for that age group. Note, only breeds with a minimum ideal senior wight of 9 pounds and over will have an intermediate class.
<b>Junior Showmanship</b>	Exhibitors age 10 to 13
<b>Kit</b>	Baby rabbit
<b>Novice Showmanship</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> year showing animals, including an 8 year old moving up from Cloverbud
<b>Rabbit – Junior Bucks</b>	A male rabbit less than 6 months of age.
<b>Rabbit – Junior Does</b>	A female rabbit less than 6 months of age.
<b>Rabbit – Senior Bucks</b>	A male rabbit 6 months of age or over in those breeds having 4 showroom classes. A rabbit over 8 months of age or over in those breeds having 6 showroom classes. An Animal having reached minimum senior breed weight, if allowed in the breed standard.
<b>Rabbit – Senior Does</b>	A female rabbit 6 months of age or over in those breeds having 4 showroom classes. A rabbit over 8 months of age or over in those breeds having 6 showroom classes. An Animal having reached minimum senior breed weight, if allowed in the breed standard.
<b>Senior Showmanship</b>	Exhibitors age 14 to 18
<b>Showmanship</b>	Must show in a long sleeve shirt or lab coat.
<b>Tag – Cavy</b>	Must be tagged in the left ear with a cavy tag
<b>Tattoo - Rabbit</b>	All rabbits MUST be tattooed in the left ear with black ink. All tattoos should be visible and easy to read. Illegible or unclear tattoos are subject to refusal.
