

## ***What does "Other" mean?***

A farm is classified as "other" when its output does not fit into one of the well defined farm types. These farms might produce unusual crops or might produce a variety of crops with no one commodity accounting for more than 50 percent of farm output. A farm might be classified as "other crop production" if it produced some vegetables, some tobacco, and fruits such as strawberries or raspberries. Other animal production includes farms that do not fit into the farm types shown or do not have one product that represents 50 percent or more of the value of their farm output.
